Basic Principle for an Easy Prosthesis

(Fixed prosthesis or overdenture)

Implants should be placed on the right place & parallel perpendicular to the occ. Plane as possible

Bone graft does everything if implants were placed in incorrect position?












The incorrect positioned implants with bone graft








Apically positioned flap after buccal bone was made





Frequent Perio.Problems even after the perio.control.















Overdenture Case







Overdenture can also be simpler & easier with correct position & angle of the implants (Slightly lingual position is OK)

Location



Poor location of implant for stud attachment

will result in unfavorable rotation and

movement of denture causing discomfort

and pain upon chewing
